### **STUDENT -INDUCTION PROGRAM (2022 Batch)**

Sachdeva College of Pharmacy, Gharuan (Mohali) conducted four days student-induction program for first year students of Pharmacy course from 12<sup>th</sup> September to 15<sup>th</sup> September 2022.
