Overview:

Activities:

- The Field Officer provided a detailed overview of the botanical garden, sharing insights into the 35-acre herbal garden and the nucleus center near Sarangpur.
- The herbal garden showcased more than 80 species of medicinal trees and 70 species of medicinal herbs.
- A nursery within the garden was explored, further highlighting the efforts of the Medicinal Plant Board (MPB), UT Chandigarh.
- The MPB's collaboration with schools and colleges in establishing herbal gardens was emphasized, promoting awareness among students and teachers about our medicinal plant heritage.

- A gift hamper containing ten medicinal plants was generously provided by the Field Officer, enhancing the educational experience for the students and faculty members.
- The visit contributed to creating awareness about medicinal plants and their importance in traditional and modern medicine.
